

**For foreign citizens wishing to pursue an education at the GASU, the following pathways for admission to the University are available:**

**1. According to the quota of the Ministry of Higher Education and Science of the Russian Federation**

Every year, the Government of the Russian Federation allocates a quota and scholarships for the education of foreign citizens funded by the Russian budget. Registration and application submissions for bachelor's, master's, and postgraduate programs at the GASU are conducted on the Rossotrudnichestvo website starting in January. For more detailed information on the selection process and deadlines, please contact the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office or the Russian consulate in your country of residence. In case of successful selection, the Ministry of Higher Education and Science of the Russian Federation issues a referral to study at the GASU according to the previously selected program.

**2. Based on the results of the Olympiads**

The following persons are eligible for admission without entrance tests: members of national teams of a foreign state - winners and prize-holders of international Olympiads in general education subjects, the list of which is approved by the Government of the Russian Federation, who are citizens of the Russian Federation or compatriots who are not citizens of the Russian Federation, in specialties and (or) areas of study corresponding to the profile of the All-Russian School Olympiad or the international Olympiad, during the four years following the year of the relevant Olympiad.

**3. According to the exam results**

• Based on the results of the Unified State Exam

To take the Unified State Exam, you must contact the examination center in your country of residence or in Russia by February 1. Exams are held before the start of the admission campaign. The results of the Unified State Exam are valid for 3 years, and starting in 2021 - for 4 years.

• Based on the results of the internal exams of the GASU

Information about the GASU 's internal entrance exams can be clarified at the GASU Admissions Office. Citizens of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Belarus, as well as descendants of compatriots, can participate in the general competition for budget places.

**Admission to the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education, including the Agricultural College, is conducted as follows:**

1) for the places funded by the federal budget allocations, the budgets of the Russian Federation regions, and local budgets, including the quotas allocated annually by the Government of the Russian Federation (budget places);

2) for the places funded by education contracts concluded upon admission, at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, as well as the organization's own funds (paid places).

**The applicant submits in person or through the Unified Portal of Public Services the documents required for admission:**

- 1) application for admission to study;
- 2) identity and citizenship document(s);
- 3) a document of education. A document of education from a foreign state must be accompanied by a certificate of recognition of foreign education unless recognition is not required under the legislation of the Russian Federation and/or international treaties;
- 4) a document confirming registration in the individual (personalized) accounting system (if available);
- 5) a consent form for the processing of personal data;
- 6) a document confirming disability as of the date of submission;
- 7) a document confirming disability or limited health capabilities as of the date of submission;
- 8) a document confirming the passage of a centralized testing or examination;
- 9) a document confirming that the applicant qualifies for special rights during admission to bachelor's and specialist's degree programs, as stipulated in Article 71 of Federal Law No. 273-FZ of December 29, 2012 «On Education in the Russian Federation»;
- 10) documents confirming individual achievements, that are taken into account during admission;
- 11) a certificate (conclusion) containing information on the medical examination (for applicants to the following fields of study: Pedagogical Education, Psychological-Pedagogical Education, Veterinary Medicine, Agroengineering);
- 12) other documents (at the discretion of the applicant);
- 13) six photographs of the size 3x4 cm.

Please note that all documents in a foreign language must be translated into Russian and notarized.
